ABOUT HELPING HANDS

Helping Hands Food Bank in Skagit County is dedicated to providing food and other essential items to those in need. As the largest no-barrier hunger solutions center in the area, Helping Hands operates six distribution sites, mobile food delivery routes, and non-food life essential distribution to ensure that all community members have access to these vital resources. Additionally, Helping Hands runs the CHOW (Cutting Hunger On Weekends) program, which provides food for children who rely on school meals.

Despite their efforts, the number of individuals seeking assistance from Helping Hands continues to grow. In fact, there has been a 71% increase in the number of people seeking assistance since 2022. To address the root causes of food insecurity, Helping Hands has implemented a Solutions Team to help individuals access resources that address issues such as unemployment, domestic violence, and homelessness. Helping Hands is making a significant impact on the lives of thousands of families in Skagit County by providing support and guidance to those in need.

ROOTED IN DIGNITY

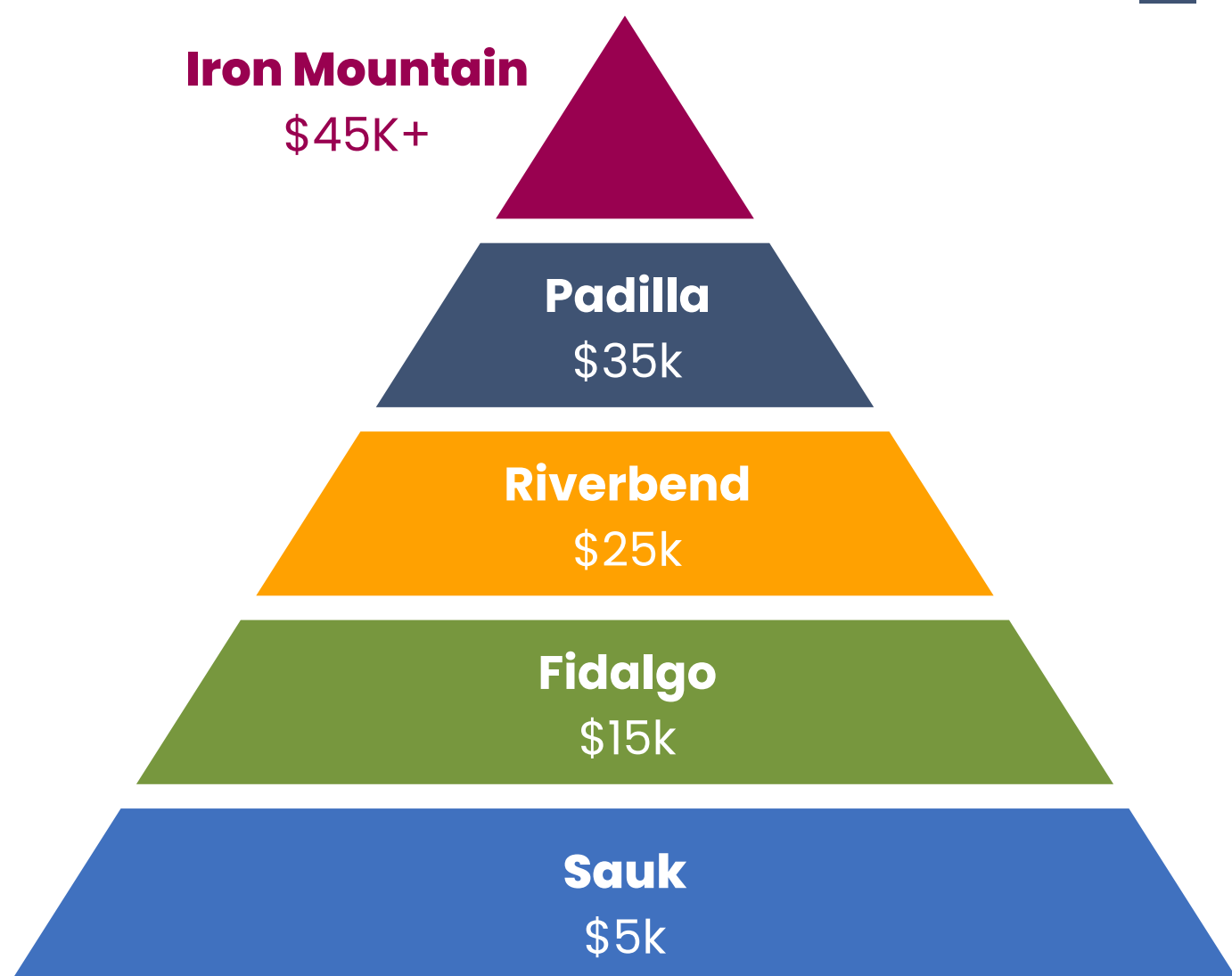
Every service and program is developed with the participant in mind, so that their dignity is reaffirmed because everyone deserves to be treated as a neighbor and valued community-member.

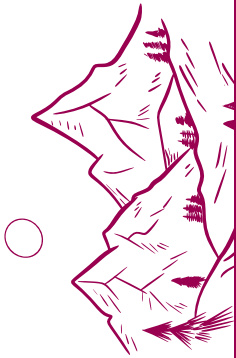


Mission:
